Section 3: Additional Information & Contacts

During Thursday and Friday there will be isolated showers. Then early Saturday morning a frontal system will pass through which is predicted to give us further 20-30mm over the headwaters (5-10mm widespread). It will remain unsettled through remainder of weekend and into Mon/Tues.

Operational barriers have been deployed at Frankwell and Coleham in Shrewsbury; Ironbridge and Bewdley (Severnside and Beales Corner), Hereford. Flood Gates are closed at Upton (New Street and Waterside). Pumps are operational at Kempsey and Ashleworth. We are closely monitoring the situation
