Section 3: Additional Information & Contacts

For today, Monday, until Wednesday, the forecast is looking predominately dry with some wintery showers. The end of the week may see a return to unsettled weather but the forecast is uncertain at present. Operational barriers have been deployed at Frankwell in Shrewsbury; Ironbridge and Bewdley (Severnside and Beales Corner), Hereford. Flood Gates are closed at Upton (New Street and Waterside). Pumps are operational at Kempsey and Ashleworth. Uckinghall flood gate is closed. The Coleham Head road barrier, Shrewsbury and Hylton Road flood barrier in Worcester were removed on Sunday. Ironbridge phase 2 is due to be taken down this morning. We are closely monitoring the situation.
